

**Volatile Organic Compounds or VOC's** are the organic solvents used in standard paint formulations, which serve as the carrier for paint pigment. When paint dries, the odor smelled is from the evaporation of VOC's used in the solvent vehicle and the tinting pigments.

**Low VOC paints and coatings** are paint products that do not exceed 50 g/L VOC, with many paints going beyond this reference. You should look for 10-25 g/L VOC. (coating VOC)

**Super-compliant paints and coatings** are defined as those coatings that have VOC content less than the VOC content limits set forth for the current and/or future limits in the Table of Standards found in paragraph (c)(2) of SCAQMD Rule 1113 and specify a VOC content less than 10 g/l VOC. (Coating VOC)
